

DIPLOMA IN THEOLOGICAL STUDIES CURRICULUM

This programme may be completed fully online.

Purpose: *To provide a programme in theology in order that the student, who does not wish to pursue a degree, may investigate in greater depth and, in a structured learning situation, the Catholic Tradition of faith.*

Goal: *To assist theology students in their faith development through input and interaction in a structured learning situation.*

Admissions Requirements:

1. Academic Application with Letter of Intent and three Letters of Recommendation.
2. Bachelor's degree or mature student with an appropriate background.
3. Official Transcripts from all post-secondary institutions.

The Diploma programme may be done on a part-time or full-time basis.

Cases which involve Advanced Standing, Shared Credits or Transfer Credits are dealt with according to the regulations found in the SAS *Bulletin*, the SAS Website, and the TST *Basic Degree Handbook*.

Courses completed in the diploma programme may be eligible for transfer to a degree programme depending on the academic eligibility of the student and the grade received for the course. Please review article **11.9** of the TST *Basic Degree Handbook* which further explains the policy regarding grades earned in the 60-69 range. Courses receiving these grades are counted towards our diploma programmes but are not transferable to a master's level programme.
