Course Reduction Policy: Students who possess the required qualifications may be eligible for Advanced Standing in the Master of Religious Education Programme. Please contact the Director for details.

The Association of Theological Schools (ATS) has approved our extension site in Aurora and our online courses. In order to meet the ATS standards and be eligible for degree completion, a student whose initial registration is May 2008 or later must take a minimum of 10 courses on our main campus sites, without exception. Students may take up to 10 courses online. If students take courses at an extension site, these credits will be allocated to the latter category. Courses taken through St. Augustine's at the Toronto School of Theology that fall within the extension site and online course category will be tracked appropriately. Students whose initial registration is January 2008 or prior also have credit restrictions and should contact the Director for details.

Criteria for **COURSE REDUCTIONS** for the
MASTER OF RELIGIOUS EDUCATION PROGRAMME
as follows:

Proper documentation is required to qualify for all course reductions:

1. A student who has earned **B.Ed. or equivalent** would have **1 Religious Education Elective** reduced from the programme.
2. A student who has completed **Religious Education Additional Qualification – Part III (Specialist) OR** shows evidence of completing it during the MRE programme would have **1 Religious Education Elective** reduced from the programme.
3. A student who has experience of **1 year of full-time teaching** would have **1 Free Elective reduced** from the programme.
4. A student who has experience of **2 years of full-time teaching OR 2 years in Parish Catechisis/Religious Education equivalent to 2 years of full-time teaching and approved by the Director of the Institute of Theology and the Dean of Studies**, would have **1 Free Elective** reduced from the programme.
